

HOUSING AVAILABILITY REPORT

In accordance with the Organic Law 4/2000 and article 42.2.e) of the Royal Decree 2393/2004, the availability of adequate housing for the foreign nationals requesting family reunification, must be proved by presenting a report. Such report will be attached to the family reunification application or residency authorization for children of non-EU residents.

If you are registered as resident in Palma, please request the above mentioned report to the Municipal Housing Board (*Patronat de l'Habitatge*) of the City Council of Palma, Housing Department (Àrea d'Habitatge), located at Plaça Nova de la Ferreria nº 2 Postcode 07002.

Family reunification and residency authorization for minor children

Procedure for family reunification.

Resident foreign nationals who wish to exercise the right of family reunification must request in person before the relevant authorities a temporary residency authorization for those family members they wish to be reunited with.

Applicants requesting family reunification must present, along with their application form, documentation certifying their family ties and proof that adequate housing is at their disposal and that there are sufficient means of support to provide for the necessities of the family once it is reunified.

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Resident foreign nationals who wish to exercise the right of family reunification must present, as part of the documentation, a report issued by the City Council proving that adequate housing for themselves and their families is available.

Family reunification and residency authorization for minor children

Situation for foreign children not born in Spain, of a Spanish parent or legal resident, or under guardianship

Residency authorization may be granted on foreign minors and disabled people not born in Spain, whose parents are resident non-EU nationals, only when they prove that they have been continuously living in Spain for at least two years and their parents or guardians fulfil the financial and housing requirements foreseen in these Regulations and required to exercise the right of family reunification.
